








7. Walk across the Golden Gate Bridge


9/6 - Ted and Anne Loney joined me crossing the Golden Gate. Had a great time with cocktails and a wonderful lunch afterwards with Kara.


10. Relay for Life - 24 HLour Walk - Diane's Peeps



1. Beey's Cabin - Mt. View January 5 locals, locals, locals,




2. The Bitter End San Franciso January 11. The homeless guy just picked up the butt off the ground. He was only wearing one shoe.


